- 3. To spread brotherhood and friendship to achieve high degree of belongingness with the College and the Society.

- 5. To promote inter se, personal and friendly relations through interactive meetings and get-togethers.

PROGRESS IN SIX MONTHS

Although just six months have passed since the formation of the Association, adequate contribution from each of the Governing Body member in spite of their very busy schedule, has resulted into some visible progress such as :-

- 1. Registration of about 70 ex-students of the College as Life Members of the Association.
- 2. Finalisation of Memorandum of Association and Rules of the Association.
- 3. Initiation of process of Registration of the Association as a "Society" under Society Registration Act.
- 4. Compilation of Accounts & audit of those Accounts for approximately first six months of the Association's existence.
- 5. Commencement of lecture series for the benefit of students of the College. The first one being on *'Personality Development'* attended by large number of students on 22nd November, 2010.

Friends, since your Governing Body is fully conscious of the fact that the best known institutions and Universities of the world like Harvard, Cambridge, Stanford, North Western University, University of Toronto etc. enjoyed immense reputation partly because of quality of their Alumni Association. Hectic efforts are being made to take this Association also to such height, which is adequate enough

to prompt young students seeking admissions to this College by evaluating the careers of we Alumni, who have passed out from this College. A lot will have to be done for reaching such height in a short time. The collective capability of your present Governing Body of just 20 members will definitely not prove enough to achieve such high goals. Each one of us and each one of those, who will be joining the Association in near future will have to contribute his/ her might to ensure a grand success of the Association in shortest possible time. If this happens, it will be a great service to the College and young students, who join it with great hopes and aspirations.
