



SHAPING THE Workforce of the Future

We are experiencing a fundamental transformation in the way we work. Automation and 'thinking machines' are replacing human tasks and jobs, and changing the skills that organisations are looking for in their workforce. These momentous changes raise huge organizational and workforce challenges – at a time when business leaders are already wrestling with unprecedented risks, disruption and political and societal upheaval.

With the pace of change accelerating, 'talent' no longer means the same as ten years ago; many of the roles, skills and job titles of tomorrow are unknown to us today. To understanding the future of work we need to consider the impact technology, automation and artificial intelligence (AI) will have on where we work and how we work.

This debate is less about technological innovation and more about the manner in which humans decide to use that technology.

The shape that the workforce of the future takes will be the result of complex, changing and competing forces. Regulations and laws, the governments that impose them, broad trends in consumer, citizen and worker sentiment will all influence the transition toward an automated workplace.

The key questions to address in this regard are:

- 1. How is the demand for workforce skills changing with automation?
- 2. How is the job landscape evolving?
- 3. How can the workforce prepare for the job revolution?

Skills in Demand – 2020 vs 2015

The world of work is changing – and some jobs are changing faster than others. Very soon we'll only be as good as the skills we possess.

Over the next ten to 15 years, the adoption of various elements of the Fourth Industrial Revolution (4IR) will transform the workplace as people increasingly interact with smart machines leading to profound shifts across all industries, reshaping production, consumption, transportation and delivery systems.

The World Economic Forum's Future of Jobs study predicts that 5 million jobs will be lost before 2020 as artificial intelligence, robotics, nanotechnology and other socio-economic factors replace the need for human workers. In this regard there is a growing need to reflect on the skill demand for jobs of the future.

Further the study also lists the skills that will be in demand in 2020 as against the skills required in 2015.

Proficiency in new technologies is only one part of achieving the desired skills equation. 'Human' skills such as creativity, originality and initiative, critical thinking, persuasion, and negotiation will likewise retain or increase their value, as will attention to detail, resilience, flexibility and complex problem-solving. Emotional intelligence, leadership and social influence as well as service orientation also see an outsized increase in demand relative to their current prominence.

Creativity will become one of the top three skills workers will need. With the avalanche of new products, new technologies and new ways of working, workers are going to have to become more creative in order to benefit from these changes. Robots may help us get to where we want to be faster, but they can't be as creative as humans (yet).

Whereas negotiation and flexibility are high on the list of skills for 2015, in 2020 they will begin to drop from the top 10 as machines, using masses of data, begin to make our decisions for us.

Similarly, active listening, considered a core skill today, will disappear completely from the top 10. Emotional intelligence, which doesn't feature in the top 10 today, will become one of the top skills needed by all.

The human workforce has the intriguing possibility of further developing uniquely human skills that machines cannot match or replicate.

The Evolving Job Landscape

With the skills landscape rapidly evolving, the jobs are becoming more abstract. Today's jobs are vastly different than they were a generation ago. As we spend more time in the virtual digital world, we see more new occupations arising.

But despite the emerging requirement to adapt to the new skill sets and prepare for the job revolution, we continue to measure workforce supply and demand in an archaic manner - via the supply and demand of job titles. This approach will lead to an increasing gap between the emerging jobs and existing skill set.

According to a World Economic Forum report the emerging jobs include data analysts and scientists, Al and Machine learning specialists, software and application developer and big data analysts. The declining jobs include data entry clerks, accounting, bookkeeping and payroll clerks and assembly and factory workers.

Creating the Desired Workforce of the Future

Role of an Individual

Continuous learning lies at the heart of thriving in the context of the Fourth Industrial Revolution. People should proactively steer their own ongoing skills development to equip themselves for the jobs of the future. In other words, recognize the need for ongoing training and shoulder the responsibility for their own education. This will improve their marketability for years to come.

- 1. Self-evaluate and undergo skill assessment
 The workforce needs to conduct a self-evaluation and answer the following questions: Are
 my skills still in demand? What's the outlook for these skills? And what skills could I work on
 today that would increase my income potential in the coming years?
- 2. Make conscious decisions

 Don't feel like you have to retrain yourself completely, all at once. As your career progresses, make decisions about which work to take based on how much you will learn.
- 3. Prioritize jobs where you will learn valuable new skills.

Role of Business & State

Enabling and empowering workers to transform and update their skills is a key concern for businesses and societies across the globe. In this scenario, Companies and government need to cooperate to create a robust and inclusive education and training system. Internship and apprenticeship programmes and vocational training will aid in preparing young people for jobs that don't necessarily require a college degree, but for which industries have specific skills needs.

Closing Thoughts....

Change is happening at breakneck speed. The key is to invest more in enabling the people to reskill to build the workforce for the future. Putting people at the centre and responding to the shift in workforce demands is crucial, because it will be the people who ultimately make the difference for organizations and communities across the globe. In all sense, the ultimate core skill for the future workforce will be 'learnability'.
